The license management of ArtemiS SUITE provides various licensing options to optimize the use of your resources and choose the best and most effective solution.

OVERVIEW

License management of ArtemiS SUITE

ArtemiS SUITE provides multiple licensing options:

- › Single User License (local)

Using a Single User License on a single workstation computer with ArtemiS SUITE installed provides you with unrestricted access to all modules of ArtemiS SUITE that are activated with this license.
- › Network License (net)

As far as Network Licenses are concerned, an administrator manages any number of licenses on a License Server and makes them available to other computers (client computers) using a license pool. All client computers in a network that are authorized by the administrator and connected to the License Server can select and use the required licenses with just a few clicks. While working, the client computers remain connected to the License Server via network and automatically return the licenses to the license pool after exiting ArtemiS SUITE, making them available to other client computers.
- › Extended Network License (net+)

Extended Network Licenses provide you with all the functions of Network Licenses and also the option of temporarily using licenses on client computers that do not need to be connected to the License Server via network (borrowing).

DETAILS

Individual licenses

With the Single User License, you are entitled to use your ArtemiS SUITE consisting of APR Framework, APR Projects (ArtemiS SUITE PRoject), and ASP tools (ArtemiS SUITE Signal Processing) on any computer that meets the system requirements. Access to ArtemiS SUITE is provided by a license file (SL – Software License) which is stored on the computer drive or a dongle (HL – Hardware License) which is connected to the computer via USB port.

Multiple licenses in the network

If you want to use ArtemiS SUITE effectively in a company with multiple licenses, choose the Network License and Extended Network License options to find the optimal solution for you.

All licenses (APR Framework, APR, and ASP) are managed by a central, license-protected License Server and assigned to authorized client computers. The client computers need to be connected to the License Server via network while working with ArtemiS SUITE.

You can quickly and conveniently select the licenses you need from the license pool. If required licenses are not currently available, the administrator can check which other client computers are using these licenses. When you exit ArtemiS SUITE, the licenses are automatically returned to the license pool.

Each individual solution you choose for the client computer requires a license for APR Framework. APR Projects and ASP Tools can be customized according to your requirements.

As an administrator, you are entitled to authorize and flexibly configure the access rights of the client computers to the license pool, even without in-depth knowledge of the network architecture.

Multiple licenses without network (borrowing)

Extended Network Licenses enable you to use licenses temporarily on a client computer without being connected to the License Server via network. For this purpose, you book licenses for a defined period of time (borrowing) in order to use ArtemiS SUITE for test drives, for example. Once the specified time has expired, the licenses are automatically returned to the license pool.

Multiple licenses in the cloud

Cloud-based solutions for Network Licenses and Extended Network Licenses are particularly easy to implement, as you do not need an own physical computer to set up a virtual machine for the License Server. In addition, all licenses can be conveniently configured and flexibly managed in the cloud.

Support for Network Licenses and Extended Network Licenses

Support for Network Licenses and Extended Network Licenses is only provided in the country in which the licenses were purchased. Support requests must be submitted by the administrator responsible for the licenses.

If the licenses are also used in other countries, there is no entitlement for support in these countries.

License Transfer

Please contact the HEAD acoustics support department before transferring a license file – e.g., when changing the computer or the License Server.

A dongle can be used on any computer with ArtemiS SUITE installed.
